¿Qué necesitamos?

- Botella de plástico de 2 lts
- Tijeras
- Rocas pequeñas
- Arena y/o tierra
- Plantitas suculentas
- Cinta
- Agua
- Decoración: confetti, escarcha, lentejuelas, listón, etc.

¿Cómo lo hacemos?

1. Corta la botella a la mitad.
2. En la parte de abajo le pones las rocas, enseguida pones la tierra, y arriba de la tierra insertas las plantitas.
3. Pon un poquito de agua.



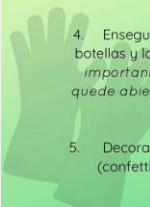
4. Enseguida pones la otra mitad de la botellas y la pegas con cinta. *NOTA: Es importante que la tapa de la botella quede abierta para que haya oxígeno dentro de la botella*

5. Decora la botella con lo que quieras (confetti, escarcha, lentejuelas, listón, etc.).

6. Riega 2 veces por semana tu jardín miniatura.

JABONES DE SÁBILA Y O ROMERO



¿Qué necesitamos?

- 2 tallos de sábila
- Licuadora
- Glicerina (la venden en tiendas de manualidades)
- Rollador
- Estufa y olla para hacer baño maría para la glicerina.
- Moldes de silicona para hacer chocolates o galletas

¿Cómo lo hacemos?

1. Con la ayuda de un adulto, toma 2 tallos de sábila y vas a eliminar las espinas a la planta con el fin de obtener la pulpa o cristal de sábila.

2. Obtenidos los cristales, se licúan hasta obtener una mezcla totalmente líquida.

3. Una vez obtenido el líquido de la aloe vera o sábila. Se prosigue a rallar los jabones de glicerina. Posteriormente, ya rallada la glicerina, se calienta al baño maría hasta que comience a quedar líquida.

4. Apagamos el fuego y vamos agregando el aloe vera licuado en estado líquido. TIP: puedes agregar gotitas de aceites esenciales para mezclar olores (menta, lavanda, romero)

5. Una vez todo unificado, pasamos esta mezcla líquida a moldes para hacer las figuras del jabón; se deja enfriar hasta que endurezcan en un lugar fresco, el tiempo variará según en la zona donde nos encontremos y la temperatura. TIP: Puedes agregar colorante vegetal o brillos a tus jabones y hacer recetas nuevas. Diviértete con tu familia!

¿Qué aprendemos con este juego?

Con esta actividad, nos acercamos a las plantas medicinales, en especial la sábila tiene grandes propiedades como: Cicatrizante, Analgésico, Coagulante, Antiséptico, Tónico, Reconstituyente, Antiinflamatorio, Regenerador, celular, Antienvejecimiento. Puedes probar hacer tus jabones con aceites esenciales de otras plantas como lavanda, romero o el que sea tu favorito.

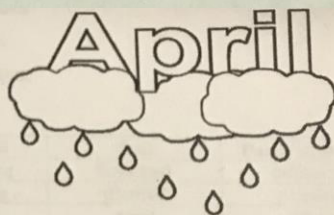
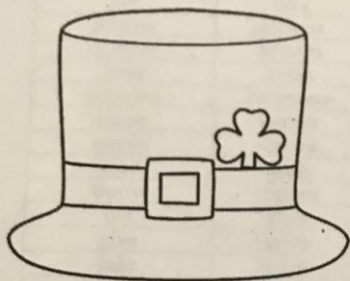
